We provide sheltered housing for retired people who have previously worked in the UK print, paper, packaging or publishing sector or allied trades. People may also be eligible if they have immediate family members who also meet the occupational criteria. Applicants must be able to demonstrate a minimum of three years' service in the sector.

Our sheltered homes promote independence for those who have retired from the industry and residents benefit from living in a comfortable, safe and friendly environment. We are a member of the Almshouses Association and work to ensure that our homes are the best they can be.

Out of hours support is provided through a helpline. Residents make a weekly maintenance contribution for their apartment.

Beaverbrook House, situated in Bletchley, and Southwood Court, in Basildon, are our two purpose-built sheltered home developments. Collectively they contain 72 one-bedroom apartments, each with their own sitting room, kitchen and bathroom. There is a small team at each home to ensure that residents have help and support when needed.
