We're here for people with a history in the printing sector and allied trades. Many of the people who contact us for assistance have immediate and at times complex needs and we work with each individual to identify their particular situation.

### Financial Assistance

Our aim is to provide relief from the effects of financial hardship, poor health and distress and we do this through one-off grants, regular financial assistance and signposting to specialist services. Our support could help with essential day-to-day expenditure, respite care or home adaptations.

### Sheltered Homes

We also run two purpose-built sheltered home developments, one in Bletchley and one in Basildon, containing 72 one-bedroom apartments, for people who have retired from the sector and can live independently in a supportive environment.

- **have worked in the printing sector or allied trades for at least three years or are a dependant of someone who has**
