The Helpline: because everyone needs someone to talk to when life doesn't go according to plan



Our helpline is free, confidential and there for everyone in our industry, whenever it's needed. No problem is too small, or too big: the helpline is there to support with personal and work-related issues, whatever they may be.

There is emotional support from BACP-accredited counsellors available 24/7/365; and access to a practical-focused information and advice service Monday to Friday, 8am to 8pm.

The helpline can also provide support in specific circumstances. It can be an independent sounding-board for managers facing challenges within their teams, or personally, whether a specific issue or something more general. And it is there for Mental Health First Aiders when the role is difficult or distressing, as well as guiding them through options for the people they're helping.

Rising Star Awards: grants to help our industry's emerging talent shine



Every year, the Rising Star Awards celebrate bright young talent in our industry. Winners at the beginning of their diverse career paths receive grants of up to £1500 to fund courses beyond role-specific employer training that will support personal development and help them progress in their careers and shine.

Anyone aged between 18-30 who works in print, paper, packaging, graphics and the allied trades is eligible to enter, regardless of role.

The key is that they know what they want to achieve from their career, and how the training they're applying for will help them fulfil their ambitions.



As proud members of the Almshouse Association, we offer affordable rental retirement apartments for people retired from our sectors who are of reduced financial means. Those receiving housing benefit are welcome to apply.

Our friendly, safe, supportive and community-focused homes are sited in Basildon and Bletchley. They provide plenty of ways to make new friends, including through the varied social activities on offer. Help is on hand if needed from our small on-site team and out-of-hours community alarm service.

To be eligible to live in our retirement developments, people must have worked in our sector for at least three years overall, or be a dependent of someone who has.
